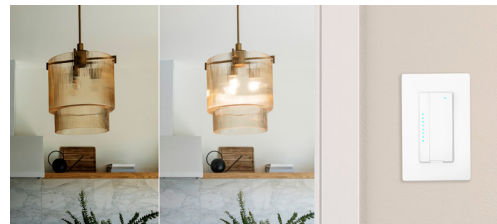

Connect to HunterSMART™

After completing installation and powering your panel, open the **HunterSMART app** or download from the App Store or Google Play.



- In the app, select add device, then follow the on-screen prompts in the app.
- When prompted, scan the **QR code** displayed on your Dimmer Switch to connect.

Tips & Tricks

- Wi-Fi is required for setup through the HunterSMART app.
- If your internet is down, you can still control devices locally over your Wi-Fi network.
- Updates happen automatically through the app.
- Use Dimmable LED Bulbs: Ensure total wattage does not exceed 200W.
- Cross-Ecosystem Flexibility: Because it's Matter-certified, the dimmer works seamlessly across ecosystems. Set it up in whichever app you prefer, no proprietary app required. A Matter controller is needed, which may be a smart speaker you already own like Echo, HomePod or Nest Hub.
- Easily Set Schedules: Use your preferred smart home platform to schedule lights to turn on/off automatically. Perfect for daily routines or while you're away.

Troubleshooting

- Need to reset? Press and hold the main On/Off button for 10 seconds until the LED flashes red rapidly.
- Hardwired switches still work even if the panel is offline.
- Weak Wi-Fi? Move your router closer or use Ethernet for stronger performance.
- 3-Way Setup Ready: This dimmer is compatible with most 3-way switch configurations to control your lights from two locations.

Where to Start

All wiring must be in accordance with national and local electrical codes ANSI/NFPA 70. If you are unfamiliar with wiring or in doubt, consult a qualified electrician. If a bare copper or green ground connection is not available in the wall box, contact a licensed electrician for installation. Please check your local wiring regulations before installation. Safekeeping the surroundings to prevent damage during product installation. Turn off the power supply when you clean the product. Dimming performance can vary if using different dimmable LED lamps. Flickering may happen when dimming at low light intensity. Use only with 120V/AC 60Hz. Do not exceed maximum rating of dimmer as indicated on the device. The wall box depth should be ≥35mm. Do NOT use with aluminum wire.

Safety First: Read Before You Begin

- Turn OFF power at the breaker before installation.
- Follow national and local electrical codes.
- Do not use with aluminum wire.
- Minimum wall box depth: 35mm.
- If your wall box has no neutral wire, call a licensed electrician.



If you're not comfortable with wiring, we recommend professional installation.

Pro Tip:

Take a photo of your existing wiring before you remove anything to make reconnection a breeze.

This product conforms to UL Standard 60730. FOR INDOOR USE ONLY.

Install in 4 Easy Steps

- 1 Remove Your Old Switch(es)**
- Turn power OFF.
 - Remove the switch plate and old switch(es).
 - Uncap the wire connectors and gently pull wires forward.

- 2 A: 1-Way Wiring Install**
- Cap the blue wire (load 2) from the wall control.
 - Connect the grounding wire (green, green/yellow stripe, or bare copper) from the box to the ground wire from the wall control.
 - Connect the red (live out) wire from the switch box to the red OUT wire from the wall control.
 - Connect the white (neutral) wires from the box to the white OUT from the wall control.
 - Connect the black (live in) wire from the switch box to the black OUT wire from the wall control.

- 2 B: 3-Way Wiring Install**
- Connect the blue wire (load 2) from the wall control to the red wire from the toggle switch.
 - Connect the grounding wire (green, green/yellow stripe, or bare copper) from the box to the ground wire from the wall control and the ground wire from the toggle switch.
 - Connect the red (live out) wire from the switch box to the red OUT wire from the wall control.
 - Connect the white (neutral) wires from the box to the white OUT from the wall control.
 - Connect the black (live in) wire from the switch box to the black OUT wire from the wall control.

- 3 Secure the Switch**
- Use included hardware to secure wall switch to switch box.
- 4 Wall Plate Installation**
- Snap the wall plate into place by applying pressure across the plate onto the dimmer switch.

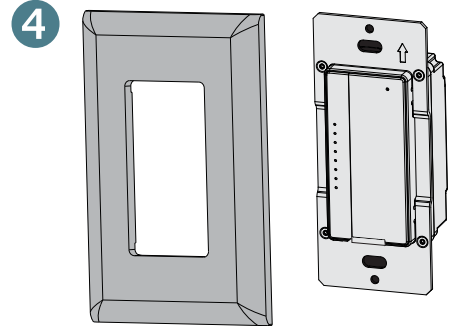
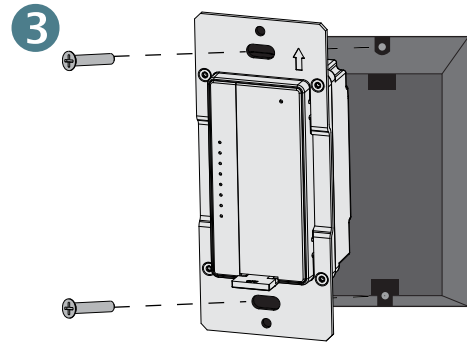
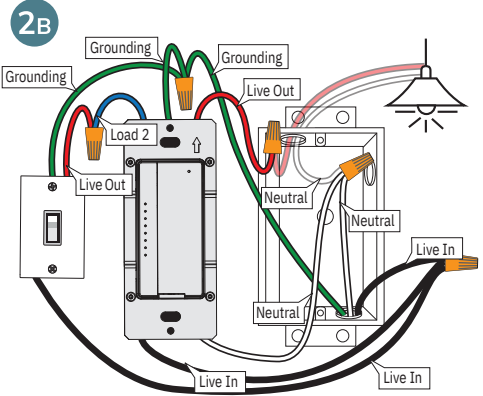
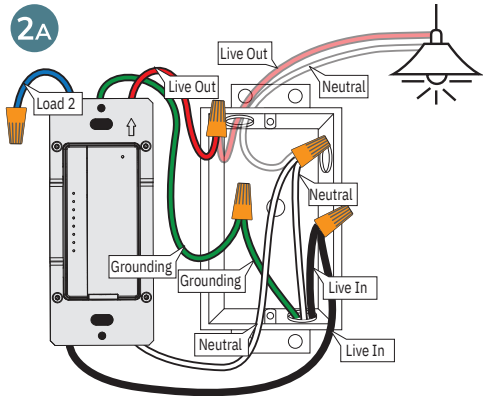
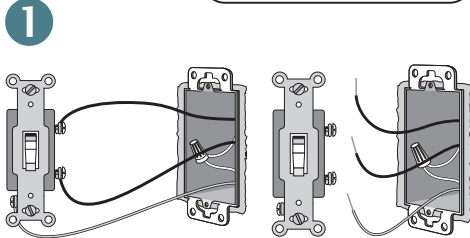


Turn Power OFF

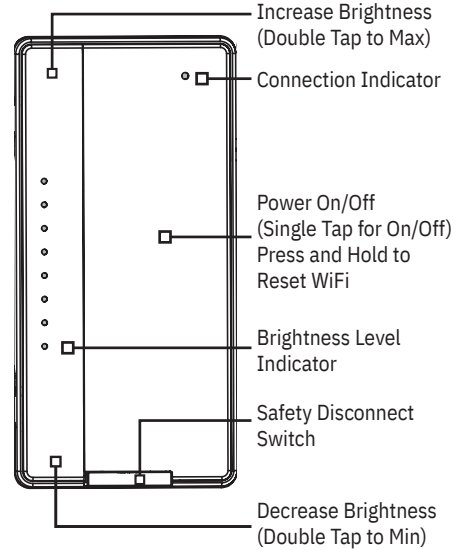
To avoid possible electrical shock, before installing your control, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breakers to the outlet box associated with the wall switch location.
